

GAME NOTES

NEW YORK AT TULSA

SATURDAY, APRIL 26, 1980

SO FAR- So far in 1980, the Roughnecks own a 3-1 record. Tulsa beat the Houston Hurricane 1-0 at Houston on March 29, with the lone goal coming on a header by Billy Caskey. Then on April 5, before a record Skelly opening night crowd of 21,138, the Roughnecks defeated Johan Cruyff and the Washington Diplomats 2-1 (Tulsa goals by Johannes "The Iceman" Edvaldsson and Alan Woodward). The Roughnecks dropped their only game of the season on April 12, 3-2 to the California Surf (despite outshooting the Surf 20-5). Last Saturday, Tulsa defeated the Express 1-0 in a shootout at Detroit. The Cosmos also enter the match with a 3-1 slate, beating Houston 4-3 (SO), losing at Ft. Lauderdale 4-1, beating Minnesota 2-1 (SO), and overwhelming Tampa Bay 4-2.

LAST YEAR- The Roughnecks finished 14-16 in 1979, good for third place in the National Conference Central Division. They defeated Minnesota in the first round of the playoffs before bowing to the Cosmos in a tie-breaking mini-game. The Cosmos ended the '79 campaign at 24-6, winning the National Conference's Eastern Division title. They beat Toronto and Tulsa in the playoffs before losing to eventual champion Vancouver in a mini-game.

SERIES HISTORY- The two clubs have met five times previously, with New York winning four of those matches. In the only '78 game, New York took a 1-0 Giants Stadium decision, then swept Tulsa in the '79 regular season, 3-1 in New Jersey and 3-2 at Skelly Stadium. In the playoffs, the Roughnecks captured their only victory of the series 3-0 at home, before dropping the second game of the series by that identical 3-0 score. In addition, New York beat the Roughnecks in the playoff tie-breaking mini-game 3-1.

ONLY ENCOUNTER- Tonight is the only meeting of the 1980 regular season between the Roughnecks and the Cosmos.

STATISTICALLY SPEAKING- In NASL statistics, Tulsa Goalkeeper Gene DuChateau is ranked third in the National Conference (sixth overall) with a 0.96 goals-against-average. Forward Alan Woodward checks in fifth in conference scoring (2 g., 1 as.). New York's Hubert Birkenmeier is tenth in the NC in GAA at 2.31, while Giorgio Chinaglia and Julio Cesar Romero are tied for first in conference scoring (tied for fourth overall) with eight points.

MORE STATS 'N STANDINGS- The Roughnecks stand in second place in the National Conference Central Division with 23 points, trailing first place Dallas by a single point. New York is in first place in the NC Eastern Division, with 26 points, five ahead of second place Washington. In team stats (all based on four games), the Roughnecks have scored six goals and allowed only four while the Cosmos have notched 11 goals and given up 10. The Cosmos are averaging 24.3 shots per game to

STATS 'N STANDINGS (CONT.)- 14.8 for Tulsa and 12 fouls per contest to 26.3 for the Roughnecks (first in the league).

THE COACHES- Tulsa boss Charlie Mitchell is in his first year as the Roughneck's Head Coach. Mitchell played for the Cosmos during his NASL career and assisted on the infamous 1976 Pele bicycle kick goal. Tonight is Cosmos' Technical Director Julio Mazzei's last game in what amounts to his role as "acting coach." The famed Hennes Weisweiler will take over the coaching reigns on April 28, following his commitment to F.C. Cologne.

OFFICIALS- The referee for tonight's game is Dante Maglio. The linesmen are Ed Bellion and William Scofield.

CHINAGLIA CLOSES IN- Cosmo Forward Giorgio Chinaglia is second on the NASL's All-Time Scoring list with 98 goals in only 104 games. He trails the retired Ilija Mitic by only three goals. Chinaglia has been a thorn in the side of the Roughnecks, scoring six goals against them (including playoffs and mini-game).

NEW LOOK ROUGHNECKS- Only six Roughneck players who finished last year's outdoor season are back in Tulsa in '80 as the Roughnecks strive for youth and stability. Gene DuChateau, Alan Woodward, Steve Earle, Iraj Danaifard, Billy Gazonas, and Alex Skotarek are the returnees.

SIDELIGHTS- Three former Cosmos are now Tulsa Roughnecks' property. Defender Kevin Eagan was acquired by Tulsa from New York last November, after playing in three games for the Cosmos. Forward Tommy Ord played for New York in 1975 and 1976, achieving Second Team All-NASL status in '75. Midfielder Jim Millinder was the Cosmos' third round draft choice in 1978....Tulsa Goalkeeper Gene DuChateau (Brooklyn native, Adelphi University) is working on an incredible streak. "Dr. Doo" has not been scored upon in the last seven penalty kicks he has faced (one so far in 1980, two in '80 pre-season, one during the indoor season, and three in '79). In addition, Detroit was frustrated in all six shootout attempts by DuChateau last Saturday. The Roughnecks have been playing very well at Skelly Stadium, winning 18 out of their last 23 Skelly contests.

INJURIES- Tulsa's injury report as of Friday listed the following: Jim Millinder-doubtful (tendinitis in knee), Viv Busby-doubtful (ankle), and Iraj Danaifard-probable (ankle). New York's reports lists: Bruce Wilson-probable (groin), "Oscar"-questionable (hip), Franz Beckenbauer-probable (thigh), Wim Rijsbergen-out (foot), Johan Neeskens-out (neck), and Seninho-probable (thigh).

BRICKLEY IN PRESS BOX- The Cosmos' Director of Media Relations Mark Brickley is in the press box tonight and available for information on the New York team.

RADIO-TV- Tonight's match can be heard in Tulsa live on KRMG (AM-740) with Bob Carpenter and Nick Hampton reporting the action. The Cosmos are providing their fans back in the New York area with both TV (WOR) and radio (WNEW). Jim Karvellas, Seamus Malin, and Lee Arthur will handle the TV commentary while Sam Rosen and Werner Roth take on the radio chores.

GETTY NIGHT- Tonight is Getty Night with 35,000 Cosmo team pictures being distributed. "Getty Shootout '80" will be held at halftime. Selected youth will attempt to score against "goalkeepers" Bob Hower and Beth Rengel of KTUL-TV. Good Luck!

NEXT GAME- Tulsa's next match will be Saturday, May 3 against the Los Angeles Aztecs at the Rose Bowl. Following a trip to Toronto, the Roughnecks will return to Skelly Stadium for a May 17 date with the New England Tea Men. New York's next action will be Sunday, May 4 when they take on the Dallas Tornado at Giants Stadium.

OTHER GAMES- Other NASL games tonight are: Rochester at Tampa Bay, Philadelphia at Dallas, Atlanta at Memphis, Detroit at Portland, Vancouver at Los Angeles, Seattle at California, and Ft. Lauderdale at S.D.
