GAME NOTES

TONIGHT'S GAME

This decisive third game of the best-of-three Quarter-Round Playoff Series will determine whether New York or Tulsa proceeds to the Semi-Finals. The Roughnecks won at home on Saturday, 1-0, to tie the series and force a third game. The Cosmos won the series opener, 5-0, one week ago.

AUGUST 28

The Roughnecks, playing a man short for the game's final 36 minutes, capitalized on home field advantage and determined whistle-to-whistle marking to defeat New York, 1-0, for the club's third win over the Cosmos in seven games at Skelly Stadium. Njego Pesa scored Tulsa's goal 23 minutes into the match to complete an assault begun with a Dave Huson shot on goal seconds earlier. Huson's attempt, made to the left of New York's goal, was punched out by keeper David Brcic but travelled directly to Barry Wallace at the top of the box. Wallace booted the rebound just outside the right post but to the foot of Pesa who heel-flicked the ball into the goal.

Referee Dante Maglio ejected Billy Caskey in the 54th minute for kicking Ivan Buljan after a foul had been whistled on the Cosmos defender. A yellow card was issued to Buljan, as well, one of seven handed out by Maglio during the match. The teams committed 38 fouls in the physical struggle as Tulsa used its narrow field and tight marking to contain New York's offense.

AUGUST 25th

Despite a scoreless first half, the Cosmos erupted for five second half goals to win the series opener and send Tulsa to its eighth straight loss in New York. Giorgio Chinaglia opened the scoring with a header at 47:27, and was followed by Bogicevic (61:05), Cabanas (66:18), a Chinaglia penalty kick (70:44) and a final goal by Buljan (81:48). Tulsa's best opportunities came on Franz Gerber and Victor Moreland breakaways in the first half and a Njego Pesa header late in the game.

THE SERIES

The Roughnecks continue to pursue their first victory ever against the Cosmos in the New York area. The overall series advantage lies with the Cosmos, 12-3.

ROUGHNECK SOCCER - TULSA'S GREATEST DISCOVERY SINCE OIL

New York has won eight straight at its home park and four of seven since 1978 at Skelly Stadium. Tulsa's wins came in 1979 (3-0, 2nd round of the playoffs), 1980 (2-1 in April) and the 1-0 win on Saturday.

ROUGHNECKS IN THE PLAYOFFS

A win tonight will push Tulsa into the 2nd round of the playoffs for the first time since 1979 when the club swept two games from Minnesota and beat New York in the second round opener. (The Cosmos ultimately won the series with 2nd and mini-game wins in New York.) The Roughnecks have never failed to make the playoffs in their five year history, but, with the exception of 1979, have never made it past the first round. Minnesota ousted Tulsa in two straight in 1978 and 1981. New York won in similar fashion in 1980. The Roughnecks playoff record is 4-8.

WHEN TULSA

The Roughnecks continue their season-long pattern of SCORES FIRST scoring in the first half--and outscoring opponents decisively in that frame. During the regular season, Tulsa outscored its opponents 34-24 in the first half but managed just a 32-29 advantage in the second half. The team scored first 21 times during the regular season and won 15 of those contests.

1982/1981

While the Roughneck defense was more vulnerable in 1982, the team's offense was far more efficient this year. The 1982 squad scored seven more goals than its 1981 counterparts -- but took 52 fewer shots. The 1982 squad also had 43 fewer corner kick opportunities. And while the team's two highest scorers both years coincidentally had identical point totals (Laurie Abrahams 44pts, Franz Gerber 32pts in 1982; Duncan McKenzie and Dean Neal the same totals in 1981), McKenzie and Neal each took 105 shots to reach their totals; Abrahams required only 86 and Gerber just 61.
