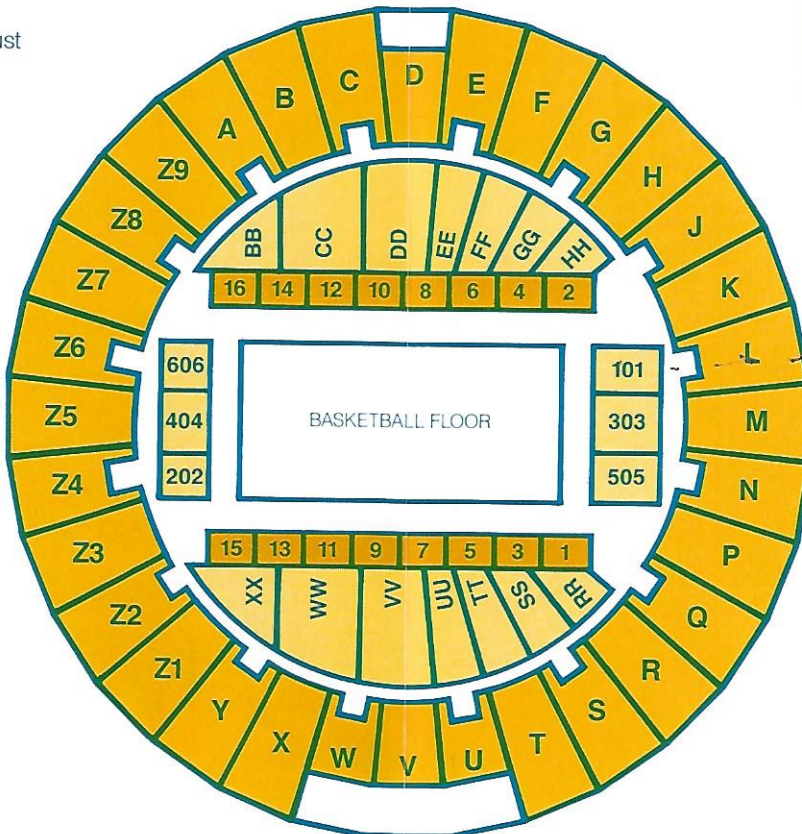

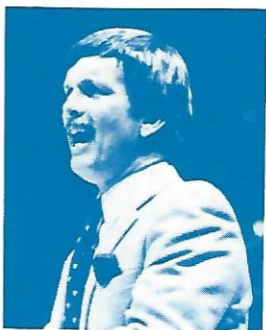

Tom Nissalke
Jacksonville Jets
Head Coach



A native of Madison, Wisconsin, Tom Nissalke attended Florida State University before beginning his coaching career on the

prep level at his alma mater of Wayland Academy in Beaver Dam, Wisconsin. He worked his way into the college coaching ranks as an assistant at the University of Wisconsin and Tulane.

Nissalke broke into the pros as an assistant with the Milwaukee Bucks in 1968, under head coach Larry Costello. His tenure in Milwaukee included an NBA World Championship in 1971.

Nissalke's first job as a head coach in the pros came later in 1971 when he assumed control of the ABA's Dallas Chaparrals (the forerunners of the San Antonio Spurs). That season he was named as the ABA Coach of the Year after guiding the Chaparrals, who were 30-54 the year before, to a 42-42 record.

After spending part of one season as coach of the Seattle SuperSonics in '72-'73, he returned to the ABA as coach of the Spurs. Nissalke continued with San Antonio until late in the 1975 season, when he went to Salt Lake City to coach the Utah Stars. Nissalke stayed in that position until the Stars disbanded during the 1975-76 campaign.

After a brief stint as a scout for Milwaukee, Nissalke returned to coaching in 1976-77 as the head coach of the Houston Rockets. In his first season, he guided the Rockets to a 49-33 record and the Central Division Championship. He was named as the NBA Coach of the Year, joining Alex Hannum and Bill Sharman as the only coaches in the history of pro basketball to earn the award in both the ABA and NBA.

Nissalke coached two more seasons in Houston, then declined the chance to become the General Manager of the Rockets in order to assume the Utah Jazz coaching duties in 1979-80. He remained in Utah until the 1981-82 season, then went to Cleveland where he received widespread praise for his work with the Cleveland Cavaliers.

Tom, his wife Nancy, and their two children Tom II and Holly, make their off-season home in Salt Lake City.
