A *Buccaneer Youth Program* is being developed, and is designed to make contact with youngsters throughout the Bay Area.

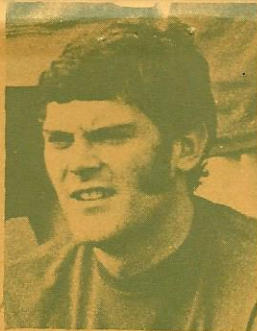

JAVIER De La TORRE
Head Coach

JAVIER DE LA TORRE's soccer credits include countless championships; as head coach for Guadalajara, De La Torre won championships for Mexico in the first division five times (1961, '62, '64, '65, and '70); two sub-championships in the same category (in 1962 and '71); two championships in the Mexico Cup Tournament (in 1963 and '70); six victories in the Champion of Champions game (between the champion of the league and the champion of the cup in 1961, '62, '65, '66, '67, and '70) International Tournament championship in a five game series in Mexico City, 1961 and the International Tournament championship in another five game series in Guadalajara, in 1962.

As a player, De La Torre was a member of the Mexican Soccer Selection in 1945, '47, '48, and '50. He was auxiliary Coach of MSS in 1968-69; Assistant Coach during the "World Cup" in 1970 and Head Coach for the MSS in Guadalajara in 1962.

CORK HIBERNIANS

The Cork Hibernians, one of the most consistently successful soccer teams in the League of Ireland during the past decade, will play a series of eleven games against the full complement of American Soccer League teams in a tour commencing Wednesday, May 19 at New Jersey and culminating June 12 in East Haven, Connecticut against the Connecticut Yankees.

The Hibernians recently concluded the Irish football season finishing fourth in the major division comprised of 18 teams.

The Hibernians came into existence in 1957 and have consistently maintained a tradition of winning football in the intervening years. They followed in the footsteps of the famous Cork United of the 1940's and the Cork Athletic of the early 1950's.

In their first year in football they signed Irish International center-forward Shay Gibbons, and other Irish Internationals who played for the team were Eddie Bailham, Jackie Mooney, Tommy Hamilton, Amby Fogarty and Tommy Eglington. The legendary Charlie Tully played for the Hibs in 1959/60 and helped them to their first Cup final, while Amby Fogarty, long time regular with the Sunderland team in England, set the foundation for the Hibernians successful run in the early 1970's when he was player-manager in 1967-69. Under his capable guidance the Hibernians captured the League of Ireland Shield in 1969.

Fogarty was followed by Dave Bacuzzi, a former Arsenal and Manchester City star, who posted the top records for the Hibernians under his guidance when they won all the major trophies in the 1970-74 period. During his tenure as coach the Hibernians won the League of Ireland Championship in 1970/71; the F.A.I. Cup in 1971/72; 1972/73; walked away with the Top Four Trophy in 1971/72 and in the following year captured the gonfalon in Blaxnit competition featuring the All-Ireland Cup.

In his term two of the club's players were honored by being selected by the Irish International teams, John Herrick and Miah Dennehy, and most of the other members of the squad were selected to play on the League of Ireland representative team.

All of the eleven games played by the ASL teams against the Cork Hibernians will count in the official League scoring statistics.

Gerard Spillane: Aged 22 and Hibs regular goalkeeper this season. Finished season with the best defensive record in the League—24 goals against in 26 matches.

John Brohan: Full-back. Aged 27 and a regular first team player for the past three seasons. Was elected "Player of the Year" by Hibs Supporters Club.

Martin Sheehan: Centre-back. An International basketball player and played for the League of Ireland representative team. Captained Ireland's Under 23 International side. Aged 24 and seven seasons with Hibs.

Jack Trainer: Centre-back. Born in Scotland and joined Hibs last season after playing for four seasons in Hong Kong. Aged 22 and 6'2" tall. Strong man of the defense.

John Lawson: Another Scot who made his home in Cork. Aged 26 and a very skillful mid-field player. Joined Hibs in 1969 after a couple of seasons with Leeds United.

Jerry Finnegan: 24 years old, mid-field player, now in his eighth season with Hibs. Born in Cork he played for Ireland's International Amateur team.

Bryan McSweeney: 24 years old, forward, who is also guesting with Hibs from Cork Celtic. Freely tipped as a future English League player. Very confident and skillful on the ball.

Damien Richardson: Played with Shamrock Rovers before transferring to English League with Gillingham three years ago. Aged 26, strong, hard-working centre-forward.

Carl Humphreys: Forward. Won F.A.I. Cup medal with Hibs in 1973, now plays with Athlone Town. Excelled against AC Milan in E.U.F.A. Cup-ties this season. Aged 24, was with West Ham for three seasons in his teens.

Bobby Tambling: Forward. Aged 25. Guest from Cork Celtic. Played with England's Senior International team on three occasions. Was Chelsea's leading player for more than a decade before moving to Cork and still holds the London clubs goal-scoring record of 164 goals. Rated the best striker in League of Ireland.

Patrick Daly: 19 years old, full-back. Has been with Hibs for two seasons and has played in the first team at mid-field as well as full-back.

Patrick Morley: Midfield. A very skillful, ball-playing left-winger. Aged 21 and regular first team player last season.

Patrick Kirby: Aged 21. A mid-field player who won a regular first team place in Hibs League team last season.

Shay Brennan: Aged 27, back. Played 19 times for Ireland's Senior International side. Won great reputation as left-back with Manchester United after he had come into the team as a teen-ager after the 1958 Munich crash. Won European Cup winners' medal with United in 1968 and had four successful seasons as player-manager with Waterford afterwards.

Peter Bryan: Aged 25, back. A member of the successful Waterford team with Brennan. A full-back, he joined Waterford from English League side Oxford United in 1966. Played for the League of Ireland representative side on several occasions.

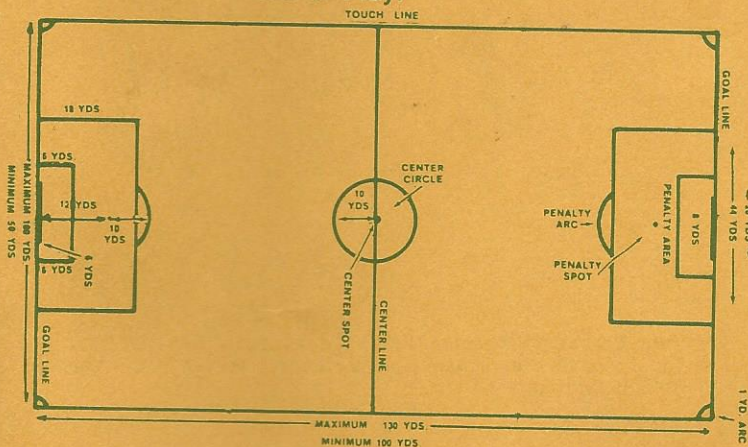
Dave Kirby: Aged 26 and a mid-field player or striker. He was born in Tramore, Co. Waterford, but lived in London from the age of five. Returned to join Waterford in 1969. Transferred to Hibs three seasons ago.

Peter Gregson: Aged 28. A goalkeeper who has had spells with Cork Hibs and Cork Celtic.

Noel O'Mahoney: Aged 24, back.

SELECTED CONDENSED LAWS OF SOCCER

LAW 1—The Field of Play.



LAW III—Number of Players. Each team consists of eleven players, one of whom must be the goal-keeper.

LAW VII—Duration of the Game. Shall be two equal periods of 45 minutes unless otherwise agreed upon or tie game.

LAW X—Method of Scoring. A goal is scored when the whole of the ball has passed over the goal-line between the goal-posts and under the crossbar.

LAW XI—Offside. A player is offside if he is nearer his opponent's goal-line than the ball at the moment the ball is played unless, (a) he is in his own half of the field of play, (b) there are two of his opponents nearer to their own goal-line than he is, (c) the ball last touched an opponent or was last played by him, (d) he receives the ball direct from a goal-kick, a corner-kick, a throw-in, or when it was dropped by the referee.

LAW XIV—Penalty Kick. A direct free kick taken at the penalty mark. All players except the player taking the kick and the goalkeeper must stay outside the penalty area and at least ten yards from the ball (hence the arc at edge of penalty area).

LAW XVI—Goal-kick. When the ball has wholly crossed the goal-line after being last touched by player from the attacking team, it is put back into play by a kick from the goal area by the defending team.

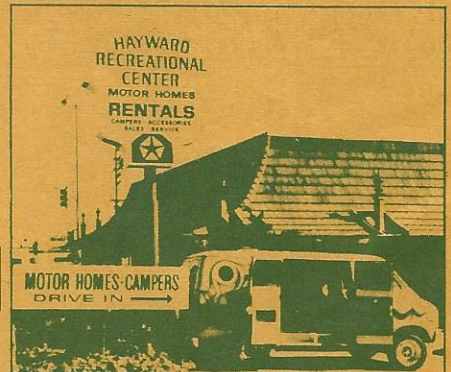

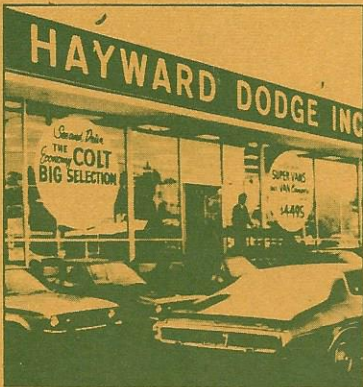
