NEW YORK UNITED vs NATIONAL TEAM OF ECUADOR Sunday, August 10, 1980 Shea Stadium 3:05

TEAM RECORDS: United is 13-9-0 with 99 points, second in the National Conference of the American Soccer League.

En route to the United States, Ecuador defeated one of the top clubs in Brazil, Cruziero by a 2-1 margin. Cruziero had previously beaten the National Team of Chile.

UNITED NOTES: Alejandro Cabrera is United's leading scorer, with 6 goals, 2 assists for 14 points. Narciso Doval and Paul Kitson are right behind, Doval with 5 goals and 1 assist and Kitson with 4 goals and 3 assists for 11 points.

Long Island born Ron Eden has scored two goals in the last two games, both of them game winners. With a 1-0 shutout victory over Golden Gate Wednesday night, Jamil Canal lowered his goals against average to 1.22. Canal has 5 shutouts on the year. He has played every minute of the season. Jimmy Sorrentino, United's majority owner and president has been named Chairman of the Board of the American Soccer League.
