- # 1 Bob Stetler GK, 6'0 185 lbs. 10-2-52, Native of USA, Last Club Tampa NASL Year: 3, Diplomats Year: 1.
  - PRO: Spent the '75 and '76 seasons with the Tampa Bay Rowdies as backup Keeper to Arnold Mausser and became expendable when Rowdies signed Paul Hammond... Joined the Diplomats in April on trial and made his debut with the club in goal vs. Las Vegas at Penn State University...he was signed shortly thereafter.
  - PERSONAL: Graduate of East Stroudsburg State College in Pennsylvania where he starred in wrestling as well as soccer...Single...likes all sports... enjoys teaching and working with kids.
