The United States National team announced the selection of Barry Barto and Bob Smith, players for the Eastern Division champion Philadelphia Atoms for an international soccer exhibition match against Poland on Sunday, August 11th, at the Willowbrook Park Memorial Stadium in New Britain, Conneticut at 4 p.m.

The United States National Team, coached by Gene Chyzowych holder of a certified "A" coaching license, is competing against the national team of Poland as part of an eight game international tour including teams from Canada and Mexico. Coach Chyzowych and the International Players Selection Committee selected the 20 player roster which also includes other North American Soccer League stars - Roy Turner - Dallas, Paul Child - Atlanta, Buzz Demling and Gene Geimer - St. Louis.

Defender Bob Smith, a native of Trenton, New Jersey, will make his debut as a national team member when the teams meet in the rematch in Conneticut. The U.S. National team lost to Poland in their first contest last week in Chicago 1-0.

This will be the eleventh international match for defender Barry Barto, who traveled with the U.S. team on a reciprocal tour in Europe sponsored by the Poland team during March and April of 1973.

In World Cup competition, Poland has already defeated England 2-0 in preliminary eliminations. The Polish team is utilizing this tour as preparation for their rematch at

Wembley Stadium in London. Should Poland tie or defeat England, winners of the World Cup in 1966, the British team would be eliminated from 1974 World Cup competition.
