RENO 1868 FC HOSTING SILVER STATE CUP RIVAL LAS VEGAS LIGHTS FC



RENO Nev. – On Saturday, Reno 1868 FC hosts southern rival, Las Vegas Lights FC, in a Silver State Cup showdown at Greater Nevada Field.

Reno 1868 FC is coming off of a bye week after earning a point on the road against Tacoma Defiance. The club currently sits at seventh in the USL Western Conference Standings with 17 points.

"The guys needed a little break so it's good we're going to be really fresh for this game," Head Coach Ian Russell said.

During the match against Tacoma Defiance, Reno was down 1-0 until forward Brian Brown found the back of the net off Seth Casiple's corner kick to tie the game up. Brown is currently Reno's leading goal scorer with seven goals and also leads the club in assists with four.

Las Vegas Light FC are also coming off of a draw in USL Championship play after a scoreless match against Tulsa Roughnecks FC. Most recently, the club was defeated 5-3 by Orange County FC in the Third Round of the Lamar Hunt U.S. Open Cup.

"Vegas looks a lot more organized this year," Russell said. "Eric Wynalda has done a good job with them. They have some good strikers, Ochoa and Parra, and they're a lot less direct this year."

This match will be the first time that Reno 1868 FC midfielder, Raul Mendiola, will play against his former club. Mendiola signed with Reno 1868 FC ahead of the 2019 season after being the top goal scorer for the Lights in 2018 with ten goals while also notching four assists.

"Raul was really one of their key players last year and we think he's got a good chance to get to the next level," Russell said. "I think Raul is excited for this game and he's been training really well so I expect a good game from him."

Saturday's match kicks off at 7:15 p.m. and gates open at 6:15. The first 1,000 fans through the gates will receive a Kevin Partida bobblehead.



WEIGHT: 170 LBS DOB: 10/3/97 Klimenta, 28, signed with Reno 1868 FC early into the 2019 season. The defender joins Reno after a lengthy career with Sacramento Republic FC. Klimenta became Republic FC's all-time leader in minutes, appearances, and starts for the club. The defender had 102 total appearances, nine goals and five assists.

#3 BENJAMIN GALINDO CRUZ (D)



HEIGHT: 6'2" WEIGHT: 187 LBS DOB: 3/10/99 Galindo Cruz, 19, joins Reno on Ioan from Chivas de Guadalajara. The forward made four appearances for the Mexican club in the 2018-2019 season and two in the previous season. He is the son of Benajmin Galindo who made 65 appearances and scored 28 goals for the Mexico national football team.

Carroll, 24, returns to Reno 1868 FC after a standout 2018 season. The 6-foot-3 defender was the team captain for the 2018 season and had 30 appearances. He scored two goals and had two assists for the club. Carroll was named Reno's Defensive Player of the Year for 2018.

The midfielder made four starts and nine appearances for FC Clncinnati while recording one of the highest passing accuracies on the team (83 percent) and won half of his aerial duels.Before joining FC Cincinnati in 2017, Seymore played for Vancouver Whitecaps FC 2 for two years (2015-2017)



Musovski, 23, was drafted by the San Jose Earthquakes in the second round of the 2018 MLS SuperDraft and then loaned to Reno 1868 FC for the 2018 season. The forward had five goals, 11 clearances and five interceptions in 17 game appearances last season.

HEIGHT: 5'5" WEIGHT: 155 LBS DOB: 3/30/94 Mfeka, 24, a returning midfielder for Reno 1868 FC helped score four goals in the 2018 season. The South American native, added three assists while boasting an 85 percent pass success rate in his 24 starts.

#11 DUKE LACROIX (D)



Lacroix, 25, a returning defender for Reno 1868 FC helped score one goal and five assists with an 82 percent pass success rate in the 2018 season. He added to his 2018 campaign with 35 clearances, 7 blocks, and 40 interceptions in 28 games.

HEIGHT: 5'10" WEIGHT: 167 LBS DOB: 5/20/90 Richards, 28, a returning defender for Reno 1868 FC boasted 122 clearances, 16 blocks, and 73 interceptions in the 2018 season. He added to a stellar defensive season with four assists and a 73 percent pass success rate in 33 games.



Apodaca, 22, was signed to Reno 1868 FC at the beginning of the 2019 season. The forward was selected 55th overall in the 2018 MLS Super-Draft by the Philadelphia Union. He later signed with the club's USL affiliate, Bethlehem Steel FC, where he spent the 2018 season. He had 17 appearances for the club, scored two goals and had two assists.
