SEASON SERIES:

Rarely does a game last only 60 minutes when Indianapolis plays Ft. Wayne. Both games this season have been decided in a shootout. The Ice won the first meeting (4-3), while the Komets came out on top last week (2-1). The home team has not lost. Season Series-Ice Record: 1-0-1

WHAT'S A SHOOTOUT:

If a game is tied following 60 minutes of regulation and a five minute overtime, a shootout will decide the winner. Each coach selects five players to go one-on-one with a goaltender. The team that scores the most wins. If the score is still tied, the shootout goes into sudden death. The game is over when one team scores and the other fails. The winning team gets two points, while the loser receives one point.

HOME SWEET HOME:

Indianapolis has won its last six home games. During that streak, the Ice has outscored its opponents, 36-15. Dave McDowall's team has allowed only eight goals during its last five home games.

DEFENSE:

Indianapolis has allowed fewer goals than any other team in the International Hockey League.

FT. WAYNE:

*The Komets have the best record of any non-affiliated team in the IHL this season.

*Former Iceman Lonnie Loach is second in the IHL with 20 assists this season.

*Bruce Boudreau, who was the IHL's second leading scorer last season, ranks sixth on the IHL scoring list this year.
