

LAX TERMS

BODY CHECK: Used to slow an opponent who has the ball. This must be above the waist and below the neck.

BREAKAWAY: One-on-one, shooter-on-goalie, scoring opportunity.

CRADLE: Method used by players to keep the ball inside the pocket of the stick by rocking it back and forth.

HIDDEN BALL PLAY: This happens when a player without the ball cradles his stick, drawing the attention of the defense, while a teammate who has the ball passes or shoots on the net.

LOOSE BALL: Occurs when there is no possession and the ball is bouncing, rolling or rebounding off of the boards or goaltender.

MAN DOWN: When a team has one less player on the floor than their opponent. This is generally due to a penalty called on the team and gives the opposing team the power play, man up advantage.

OFFENSIVE PICK: Legal interference by an offensive player from a set position on a defensive player who is trying to defend the ball carrier.

OUTLET PASS: The first pass from the goaltender or defender that begins the transition from defense to offense.

SCREEN SHOT: When the goaltender can't see a shot because someone is in the way.
