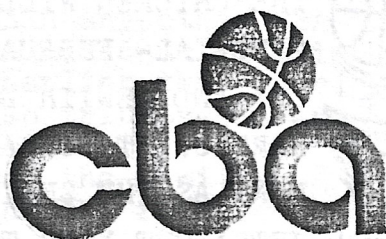
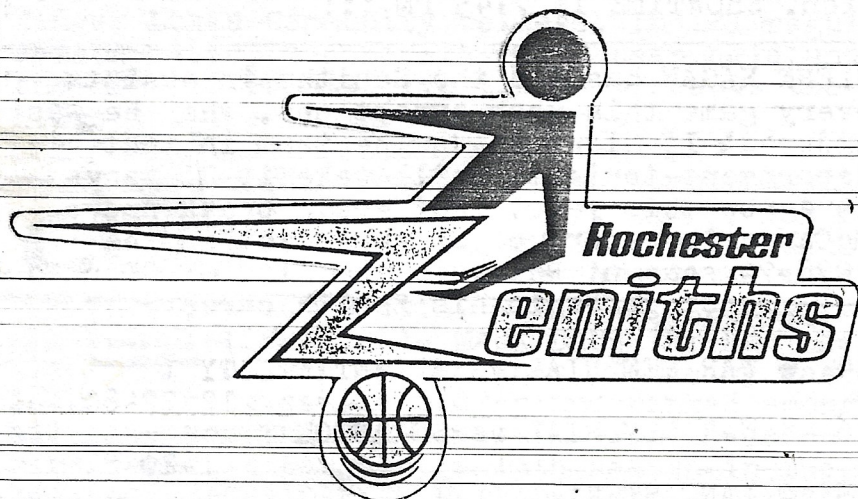

The Zeniths winning percentage of .815 (22-5) is better than every finishing team in the league going back to the 1975-76 season! This includes Mauro Panaggio's championship team in 1978-79 which closed with a 36-12 record (.750). Mauro is challenged to keep the Z's tuned as the CBA slips into its final third of the 1980-81 campaign. The Zeniths play 8 of their final 12 games on the road.

The Z's are coming off the pasting of Scranton on Thursday, when four individual and personal Zenith records were broken! (see back page)

Larry Fogle has climbed to number 6 on this year's CBA scoring list. He's led the Z's in points scored in six of the last 11 games going over 3,000 pts in his CBA GP!

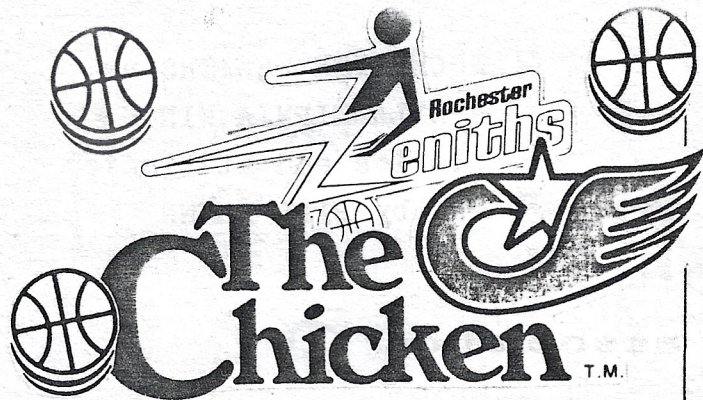

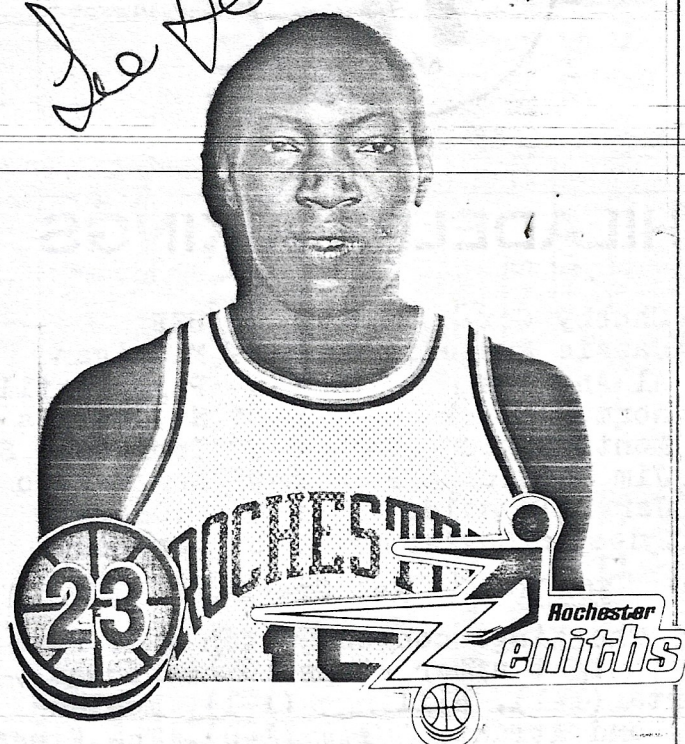

LEE JOHNSON, 1st Round Draft of the Houston Rockets in 1979, is making quite an impression with the Zeniths after only 16 games played! Lee has broken Zenith records in one game for blocked shots, rebounds and field goals! In the last six Z contests, Lee is shooting 62% from the field on 61 of 99 shots! In that span, Lee has averaged 26.3 points and 13.3 rebounds along with an 80% touch from the line and 3.3 blocked shots a contest! Lee is ranked 2nd in CBA blocked shots and soon will be among league-leaders in rebounds. He's currently atop that Zenith categorie averaging better than 10 'bounds a game!

The Philadelphia Kings have had more success against the Zeniths than any other CBA team. The Kings (Lancaster Red Roses until this year) were beaten by the Z's earlier this year by twelve at the Dome, but also triumphed over Rochester 107-97 at Philly last month. In the last meeting between the clubs, the Zeniths squeezed out a 98-97 victory on the road.

Lancaster won both games at Rochester last year. They spoiled the Z's home debut, 94 to 92 at the Dome and beat Rochester at the Finger Lakes Community College. In 121 regular season games, the Zeniths have been held under one-hundred points five times- three to the Roses and the Philadelphia Kings.

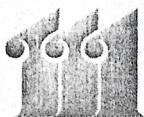
