2004 Coaching Staff

Albany Conquest Head Coach



Rick Buffington

Rick Buffington took over as head coach of the Albany Conquest heading into the team's sixth game of the season. At the time, the Conquest had a 1-4 record and Coach Buff led the team to a respectable 5-6 record during his 11 games as head coach this season. He has a strong football resume, having become a part-time scout for the New York Jets in 1976 before joining the New England Patriots coaching staff from 1978-1981. With the Patriots he worked along side numerous notable coaches, including Bill Parcells. Buffington was the first head coach of the former Albany Firebirds, having served in that role from 1990 to 1993, leading the Firebirds to the playoffs in three out of four seasons. Buffington has also served as head coach for four other arena football teams. He was Head Coach and General Manager of the Arena Football League's Connecticut Coyotes in 1995. Buffington was Head Coach and Director of Football Operations for the Charlotte Rage of the Arena Football League in 1996. He was Head Coach of the AFL's Florida Bobcats in 1998 and GM in 2000. He also served as Head Coach and General Manger of former arenafootball2 team, the New Haven Ninjas (2002).

Assistant Head Coach Dave Bochette:

Dave Bochette concluded his second season with the Conquest and was Assistant Head Coach. Bochette stepped up this season as the team's Interim Head Coach helping guide the Conquest to a 52-45 win over the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Pioneers on May 8.

Defensive Coordinator Bill Cook:

Bill Cook finished his third season with the Conquest and was the team's Defensive Coordinator. For the previous two years, Cook had been Defensive Backs and Special Teams Coach with the Conquest.

Offensive Coordinator Nick Fitzgerald:

Nick Fitzgerald was Offensive Coordinator and coached the offensive and defensive lines for the Conquest in 2004. He was Defensive Coordinator and FB/LB Coach for the Conquest during their 2002 season.

Regional Scout Bruce Bochette:

Bruce Bochette was the Conquest's Regional Scout for a third year in 2004.

2nd season

2004 Season: Rob Green led the Conquest with 79 tackles (7th in af2) and was twice named ADT Defensive Player of the Game. Green also had 24 passes defended (tied for 12th in af2) this season. His interception with 23 seconds remaining helped clinch Albany's 60-56 win over the Louisville Fire on May 15. He had four interceptions and forced two fumbles. He recovered two Albany on-side kicks in his first game with the Conquest on April 24. **af2 career:** Green played in 14 games last season with the now-defunct Cincinnati Swarm as a defensive specialist. He totaled 66 tackles, including 46 unassisted. He also had five interceptions, 24 passes broken up, three forced fumbles and three recovered fumbles. **College:** Green was a defensive back at the University of Massachusetts where he played in 2000 and 2001. Prior to that, he was a JUCO All-American at Nassau Community College.

4, Ralph Barone (QB)

Vitals: 5-10, 190, 10/7/1970

College: Northeastern

Hometown (High School): Schenectady, N.Y (Mohonasen High School)

Rookie

2004 Season: Ralph Barone saw his first playing time of the season on June 6 and was 2-of-5 passing for 25 yards leading Albany on a scoring drive on their final possession of the game against Cape Fear. **College:** Barone was a standout at Division I-AA Northeastern University. He set numerous single season passing records at Northeastern, including total offense (2,814 yards), completions (183), attempts (355), and touchdowns (20). He set single game records including marks for touchdown passes (6) and total offense (380 yards). Prior to his two seasons at Northeastern (1991 and 1992), Barone was an Honorable Mention NJCAA All-American at Hudson Valley Community College passing for 1,667 yards in 1990, second most in school history. Barone played for Conquest Assistant Head Coach Dave Bochette at Hudson Valley. Barone, from Schenectady, N.Y., was a standout at Mohonasen High School. **Other Professional Career:** Barone's professional football resume includes free-agent tryouts with the CFL's Toronto Agronauts and Arena Football League's Florida Bobcats. He has played semi-pro football for the Marlboro Shamrocks in Massachusetts for the past 10 years, and most recently last summer. A southpaw quarterback, he performed action scenes for Dennis Quaid in the movie "Any Given Sunday."

2nd season

2004 season: Rashon Burns had 11.5 tackles with three tackles for a loss, 1.5 sacks, and four QB hurries this season. He also carried the ball 52 times for 203 yards (6th in af2) with seven touchdowns. **af2 career:** He played in nine games with the Conquest last year, totaling 50 yards rushing on 15 carries with one TD. He also had one receiving TD. Defensively, he tallied five tackles and a pass broken up. **College:** He attended East Carolina University, and in 1999 made the most of his first "real" opportunity as a regular tight end, his natural position, notching 25 receptions for 236 yards and two touchdowns. He ranked third on the Pirates in catches. As a fullback, he rushed five times for 48 yards, getting 9.6 yards per carry. In 1998 he saw limited action as a linebacker on defense, recording five tackles, including four solo tackles. **Other Professional Career:** He attended training camp with the Chicago Bears and was invited to a workout with the Indiana Firebirds in 2002.

2nd af2 season

2004 Season: Tony Locke, offensive specialist, led the Conquest with 79 receptions for 1,497 yards and 39 TD receptions this season. Locke had one rushing TD and returned three kickoffs for touchdowns. Locke ranked in the top four in af2 in four offensive categories. He was second in scoring (260 points), tied for second in touchdowns (43), fourth in receiving yards (1,497), and second in all-purpose yards (2,868).

Arena Football career: Locke, offensive specialist for the Conquest, joined the team after playing in four games this season for the Columbus Destroyers of Arena Football League. With the Destroyers, he caught five passes for 36 yards. **2003:** Locke played for the former Cincinnati Swarm of af2, catching 22 passes for 298 yards and five touchdowns. He was also returned kicks averaging 22.8 per return, with two touchdowns. He had ten tackles, two interceptions, and two passes broken up. **College:** Locke was a two-year letter winner at The Ohio State University. He played behind David Boston and was on the Ohio State squad that earned a Big 10 Championship and Sugar Bowl win during the 1998-1999 season.

2004 Season: Nick Anderson had 14 tackles with two for a loss, two sacks, a forced fumble, and three QB hurries this season. He also had four receptions for 43 yards with three touchdowns. **af2 Career:** Anderson played in all 16 games for the Conquest in 2003, totaling 11 tackles, 4.5 sacks, two forced fumbles, two fumble recoveries, and a safety. Anderson began his arena football career with the Iowa Barnstormers in 2001, amassing 16 tackles with five for a loss and 3.5 sacks. Anderson also recorded a safety, a blocked kick, and an interception, which he returned 19 yards for a touchdown. He played for the Columbus (GA) Wardogs in 2002 recording 18 tackles, 3.5 sacks, and one forced fumble. During his three-year af2 career, he has caught five passes for 55 yards and scored four touchdowns playing from the tight end position.

Other professional experience: Anderson participated in training camp with the Columbus Destroyers of Arena Football League (AFL) in January.

2004 Season: Travis Coleman led the Conquest with 33 passes defended, which also ranked him third in af2. He was second on the team with 66 tackles and he had four interceptions and a forced fumble this season. Coleman was named the ADT Defensive Player of the Game in five of 16 games this season. **NFL career:** Coleman played in seven games for the Bears in 2002 starting on special teams in kick-off and punt-return coverage. He was on the Bears practice squad for the first nine games of the season before being activated. Defensively, he played cornerback for the Bears and his most notable game was in a 20-13 win over the New York Jets in Week 15. He made two tackles, including one for a loss and covered then Jets wide receiver, Laveranues Coles. Coleman also spent time in training camps with the Detroit Lions and Indianapolis Colts prior to the 2003 NFL season.

College: He was a second-team all-conference selection at strong safety his junior season for Division I-AA Hampton University of the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference. At Hampton during his four-year career, he totaled 147 tackles, 13 interceptions and 48 passes broken up.

2004 Season: Vinny Cirrincione, at 21-years of age, was the second youngest player to ever play in an arenafootball2 game. In 13 games this season, he converted 55-of-71 (78.6 %, 6th in af2) PAT attempts and nine field goals of 56, 42, 38, 38, 32, 29, 28, 26, and 22 yards (9th in af2). His 56-yard field goal on June 6 was the longest in franchise history. **Other professional experience:** Cirrincione had been working out with the Albany Conquest at practices for the past two years. He has had tryouts with the New York Dragons of Arena Football League and played for semi-pro football team, Kings Bay Knights. Cirrincione, like many professional kickers is a converted soccer player having played high school soccer in New York City.

2004 Season: Jeff Higgins had 50 catches for 560 yards and five touchdowns this season. He ranked fourth on the team with 29 tackles, had two interceptions, and an assist on a sack. He also returned one kickoff for a touchdown. **af2 Career:** Higgins was a roster member of the Conquest in 2003, but was placed on long-term injured reserve with a shoulder injury. He played for the Macon Knights in 2001 scoring 17 touchdowns (11 receiving, 4 rushing, 2 kick returns). In 2002, he played in four regular season games and two playoff games for the Cape Fear Wildcats, including a 46-30 second-round af2 playoff victory over the Conquest on August 10, 2002 in Fayetteville, N.C. **College:** He was a Hewlett Packard and Football Gazette Division III All-American in 1995 and 1996 playing at Ithaca College. **Other Professional Experience:** Higgins was invited to NFL a personal workout with the Dallas Cowboys (1999) and to closed invite camp with the Baltimore Ravens (1998). Higgins has been an active member of the coaching staff at Corinth High School for the past two years as offensive coordinator and will be head coach this fall

Cape Fear Wildcats 70, Albany Conquest 55

Fayetteville, N.C., April 10, 2004 - Matt Burstein (OS) caught seven passes for 149 yards and four TD's as the Cape Fear Wildcats defeated the Albany Conquest, 70-55, in a Northeast Division game and season opener for both teams on April 10 at the Crown Coliseum in Fayetteville, N.C.

"Cape Fear is one of the toughest teams in arenafootball2 (af2)," said Albany Conquest Head Coach Steve Matthews. "They were better tonight, but I have a lot of confidence in this team. We will move forward and prepare for Manchester on our home turf Friday. We will practice in the Pepsi Arena all week and that will help a lot," added Coach Matthews.

Cape Fear's 70 points was the most scored against the Conquest (0-1), in the team's three-year history in af2. Wildcats QB Chris Wallace, a three-year af2 veteran out of the University of Toledo, was 14-of-17 passing for 226 yards and threw six TD passes. He also rushed for one score. With the win, Cape Fear (1-0) improved their series record against the Conquest to 3-0.

Conquest QB Gus Ornstein, in his second season with the Conquest, threw seven TD passes with one interception and was 22-of-40 passing for 315 yards in his first af2 start. Jamie Ware (WR/DB) led all Conquest receivers with six catches for 101 yards and one TD. Adriel Linyear (WR/LB) caught five passes for 44 yards and two TD's, while Jim Jones (WR/LB) had four catches for 74 yards and two touchdowns. Tony Locke (OS) and Timothy Perren (FB/LB) also caught one TD pass. Perren also rushed for a score.

Manchester Wolves 47, Albany Conquest 34

Friday, April 16, 2004 -- Albany, N.Y. - The Albany Conquest played their home opener on April 16 at the Pepsi Arena in front of 7,129 fans, but lost to the Manchester Wolves, 47-34. Fans still had a lot to cheer about as the Dallas Cowboys Cheerleaders performed two action packed performances and the Sunations Treasures Dance Team thrilled the crowd with their first performances of the season.

Manchester Wolves QB Chris Sanders was 25-of-37 passing for 298 yards with six TD passes, three to Reggie Robinson and three to George Williams. Manchester jumped out to an early 7-0 lead when Sanders hit Williams with 10:39 remaining in the first quarter. Albany responded by pulling to within one at 7-6 when Jamie Ware got loose in the secondary catching a 35-yard TD pass from QB Gus Ornstein. Sanders tossed his second TD

pass, this one a 14-yard pass to Robinson giving Manchester a 14-6 advantage early in the second quarter. After an Albany score that again closed the gap to one at 14-13, Manchester rattled off 21 unanswered points to take a 35-13 lead. Albany mounted a comeback pulling to within 41-34 following a D Bryant touchdown pass to Tony Locke with 5:20 remaining in the game, but Manchester quickly responded with a 10-yard rushing score from Robinson to tarnish Albany's hopes of a come-from-behind victory.

Ornstein was 12-of-18 passing for 174 yards with two TD's and three interceptions. D Bryant, who entered the game late in second quarter, was 7-of-12 passing for 126 yards with three TD's and one interception.

Louisville Fire 62, Albany Conquest 56

Albany, N.Y., April 24, 2004 -- James Scott (OS) scored on a nine-yard TD pass from quarterback Matt Sauk with just three seconds remaining in the game giving Louisville Fire a 62-56 victory over the Albany Conquest at the Pepsi Arena on April 24.

"That was an emotional game," said Albany Conquest Head Coach Steve Matthews. "We fought back and put ourselves in a position to win, but Louisville is a tough team and they did not give up either," added Matthews.

Sauk, who earned Baby Ruth Real Deal Offensive Player of the Game honors, threw seven TD passes with just one interception and was 20-of-32 passing for 290 yards. Scott had 12 catches for 171 yards and four TD receptions for the Fire (3-0). The Albany Conquest (0-3) had taken the lead, 56-55, with 13 seconds remaining in the game on a Jamie Ware (WR/DB) 2-yard TD run. Ware caught five passes for 90 yards with two receiving TD's and one rushing score, along with three passes broken up on defense to help earn him the US Army Ironman of the Game honors. Conquest QB Gus Ornstein was 18-of-32 passing for 265 yards with seven TD's and just one interception. In addition to his two touchdown throws to Ware, he threw two each to Tony Locke (OS) and Jeff Higgins (WR/LB), and one to Adriel Linyear (WR/LB).

Manchester Wolves 51, Albany Conquest 34

Manchester, N.H., April 30, 2004 -- The name of the game was accuracy as Chris Sanders led the Manchester Wolves to their first home victory, 51-34, on April 30 against the Albany Conquest. The Wolves win came before an enthusiastic crowd of 8,140 at the Verizon Wireless Arena. Sanders earned Baby Ruth Real Deal Offensive Player of the Game honors after an impressive showing. He completed 17-of-22 passes for 271 yards and accounted for seven touchdowns (4 passing, 3 rushing).

The Albany Conquest were led by Tony Locke, offensive specialist who caught four passes for 74 yards and three TD's. QB Gus Ornstein was 15-of-37 passing for 215 yards and four TD's with one interception. The Conquest's Jamie Ware (WR/DB) had one TD catch. Adriel Linyear (WR/LB) ran for one score.

The ADT Defensive Player of the Game Award was split between Manchester's Reggie Robinson and Albany's Rob Green. The Conquest totaled five sacks in the game, two by Rich Barlette, two by Thomas Herron and one by Ron Simone.

Robinson earned the defensive achievement by swarming on the Conquest's key players. Robinson also played well on offense, catching a game-high eight passes for 105 yards. Green had seven tackles (four solo, three assisted) and was the key to making Manchester's offense work hard for every touchdown.

The ARMY Ironman of the Game went to Kelvin Fuller of the Wolves. Fuller was not only an offensive contributor (one reception for 30 yards), but he also registered two tackles for a loss of 12 yards and had one sack for a loss of 11 yards.

The Wolves also earned a spot in the af2 history books in the battle, which lasted over three hours. Manchester set a new record for most penalty yards for one team in a game as they were penalized 23 times for 194 yards.

Albany Conquest 52, Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Pioneers 45

Albany, N.Y., May 8, 2004 -- Quarterback D. Bryant scored on a rushing TD with just 12 seconds remaining in the game to propel the Albany Conquest (1-4) to their first victory of the season, a 52-45 win over previously unbeaten Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Pioneers (4-1) on May 8 at Pepsi Arena. The Pioneers had entered this Northeast Division battle as the top-ranked team in the arenafootball2 Coaches' Poll, which was released earlier in the week.

Bryant, making his first start as an arenafootball2 QB, went 18-of-28 passing for 210 yards with two TD passes and three rushing touchdowns. Bryant's efforts earned him Baby Ruth Real Deal Offensive Player of the Game honors.

"What a great win," said Albany Conquest Interim Head Coach Dave Bochette. "We had a solid week of practice and our guys really earned this win. They deserved it," he added.

The game was tied on three occasions and had eight lead changes. Conquest offensive specialist Tony Locke caught seven passes for 89 yards with both a receiving TD and rushing TD. Conquest WR/DB Jamie Ware, US Army Ironman of the Game, had two catches for 40 yards with one TD, while recording a crucial interception on defense just after the start of the second half. With Albany trailing 27-21, Ware picked off Pioneers QB Tim Hicks, giving Albany the ball at their own 20 with 10:40 remaining in the 3rd quarter. The Conquest scored on their next possession on a 1-yard D Bryant rushing TD giving Albany their second lead of the game at 28-27 with 8:22 remaining in the third quarter.

Conquest kicker Vinny Cirrincione, who was a perfect 7-of-7 on PAT attempts, extended the Conquest lead to 31-27 when he converted a 42-yard field goal on the Conquest's next possession.

The Pioneers battled back and after four more lead changes, Hicks connected with Wilkes-Barre offensive specialist J.R. Thomas on a 37-yard TD to tie the game at 45-45 with 36 seconds remaining in the game. Hicks finished 20-of-34 passing for 310 yards with five touchdowns and one interception. Thomas led all Pioneers receivers with six catches for 127 yards and two TDs.

Albany Conquest 60, Louisville Fire 56

Louisville, Ky., May 15, 2004 -- Coach Rick Buffington won his first game as head coach of the Albany Conquest on May 15 as he led the team to a 60-56 victory over the Louisville Fire in front of a crowd of 8,347 fans at Freedom Hall in Louisville, KY. Coach Buffington was overcome with emotion as his team earned a come-from-behind victory in the fourth quarter notching their second straight victory.

Defensive back Rob Green played a stellar game as he intercepted Fire QB Matt Sauk with 23 seconds remaining to stop a potential scoring drive late in the game.

Quarterback D. Bryant ran for two TDs, including a 40-yard touchdown, while throwing for six more TDs to lead the Conquest. He was 13 for 25 for 314 yards. Wide receiver Tony Locke had eight catches for 212 yards and four TDs. Conquest wide receivers Jeff Higgins and Calvin Ceaser both caught first half TD passes.

But the night belonged to Coach Buffington, who had his team playing with a ferocity and desire. In fact, the Conquest stopped three drives of the Fire and kept pressure on Louisville quarterback Matt Sauk.

Albany Conquest 56, Macon Knights 37

Albany, N.Y., May 22, 2004 -- Offensive Specialist Tony Locke tied an all-time Albany Conquest record with five receiving touchdowns as Albany rolled to a 56-37 win over the Macon Knights on May 22 at the Pepsi Arena.

"This team is really playing with a lot of heart and emotion," said Albany Conquest Head Coach Rick Buffington. "Tony did a great job getting open and really had a solid game. This team is playing together and that has equated to three straight wins. You have to love it," added Coach Buffington.

The Albany Conquest (3-4) cruised out to a 21-0 first quarter lead when QB D. Bryant connected with Locke on a 28-yard TD pass. Bryant was 18-of-28 passing for 282 yards with six TD passes. He also rushed for one score, his sixth rushing TD of the season. Locke, who earned Baby Ruth Real Deal Offensive Player of the Game honors, caught his third TD pass from Bryant putting Albany ahead 41-19 with 30 seconds remaining in the first half. Macon (2-5) had pulled to within 44-30 on QB Cecil Lester's one yard TD run with 5:14 remaining in the third quarter, but the Conquest quickly responded when Locke caught his fifth TD pass of the game, a 22-yard strike from Bryant that gave Albany a 50-30 lead with just over 12 minutes left in the game.

Macon was led by Lester, who finished the game 16-of-32 passing for 230 yards with three TD passes and one interception. Albany defensive specialist Rob Green earned ADT Defensive Player of the Game honors, while the Conquest WR/LB Jeff Higgins garnered US Army Ironman of the Game honors.

The win was the third straight for the Conquest, who avenged a Macon 59-47 win over the Conquest in last year's ArenaCup playoffs at Pepsi Arena on Aug. 9, 2003.

Peoria Pirates 44, Albany Conquest 24

Peoria, Ill, May 29, 2004 -- Peoria Pirates WR/DB Lawrence Matthews had two receiving touchdowns and an interception return for a TD as the Pirates stopped Albany from getting a fourth straight win by beating the Conquest, 44-24 on May 29 at Peoria Civic Center in Peoria, Ill.

Albany (3-5) struck first in the contest when QB D. Bryant hit offensive specialist Tony Locke on a 30-yard TD pass on the Conquest's first play from scrimmage. On Albany's second play from scrimmage, Matthews intercepted Bryant and went 12 yards for the score giving Peoria a 14-7 lead midway through the first quarter. Bryant was 14-of-35 passing with two TDs and four interceptions.

Both of Bryant's TD passes went to Locke, who also had a 57-yard kickoff return for a touchdown that brought Albany to within seven of Peoria and making the score 21-14 in the beginning of the second quarter. Locke has 20 receiving touchdowns, two kick returns for scores and one rushing TD this season.

The Conquest's 24 points tied an all-time franchise low. Albany was limited to 229 yards total offense. Peoria's (3-5) defense entered the game ranked fifth in arenafootball2 giving up just 38.9 points per game.

Cape Fear Wildcats 78, Albany Conquest 51

Albany, N.Y., June 6, 2004 - Offensive Specialist Matt Burstein caught four touchdown passes leading the Cape Fear Wildcats to a 78-51 win over the Albany Conquest on June 6 at the Pepsi Arena in Albany, N.Y.

Burstein's fourth TD catch, a 22-yard strike from Cape Fear QB Mike Gluski, put the Wildcats ahead 46-31 with just under two minutes remaining in the third quarter. Burstein earned Baby Ruth Real Deal Offensive Player of the Game honors catching TD passes of 38, 30, 27, and 22 yards. Burstein had seven catches for 157 yards. Gluski, making his second start for the Wildcats, was 20-of-32 passing for 314 yards with seven TDs and three interceptions.

Albany had led on two occasions in the first quarter of the game, first when QB D. Bryant threw a 30-yard TD pass to Tony Locke putting the Conquest ahead 7-6, then when Cy Butler caught an 18-yard TD reception from Bryant giving Albany a 14-13 advantage late in the first quarter. Bryant was 10-of-21 passing for 143 yards throwing three TDs and two interceptions.

Early in the second quarter, Albany drew to within a 19-17 score when kicker Vinny Cirrincione booted a 56-yard field goal, which set an Albany Conquest franchise record for distance. Locke had 227 all-purpose yards in the game. He caught two passes for 37 yards with one TD and amassed 190 yards in kickoff return yardage, including a 56-yard kickoff return for a touchdown, his third kick return for a score this season.

The Conquest's Travis Coleman earned ADT Defensive Player of the Game honors recording two interceptions and two passes broken up. He also had three tackles, including an assist on one for a loss.

With the win, Cape Fear (5-3) remained in second place in the Northeast Division and earned their second victory of the season over the Conquest (3-6), who allowed the most points in a single-game in franchise history. Cape Fear posted a 70-55 win over Albany back on April 10 in Fayetteville, N.C.

Albany, N.Y., June 12, 2004 - The Albany Conquest broke a two-game losing skid with a 66-54 victory over the Arkansas Twisters on June 12 at ALLTEL Arena in N. Little Rock, Ark. in front of 6,775 fans getting themselves back into the arenafootball2 playoff hunt. Albany increased their record to 4-6, while Arkansas fell to 1-9.

Albany QB D. Bryant connected with offensive specialist Tony Locke on touchdowns of 29, 9, 28 and 45-yards, all in the first half as Albany went into halftime with a 42-27 lead. The latter score of 45-yards happened on the last play of the half with no time remaining on the clock. Bryant played one of his best games of the season and was 11-of-24 passing for 254 yards with six TD tosses and no interceptions. Locke continued his stellar play catching six passes for 174 yards with four touchdowns. Locke has 29 touchdowns this season and is seven scores away from tying Corey Hill's franchise record of 36 touchdowns in a season.

Albany's Calvin Ceaser had one of his top performances of the season collecting three catches for 54 yards with a 42-yard TD reception that gave Albany a 49-27 lead early in the third quarter. He also had two tackles and a key interception in the Conquest's endzone that gave Albany the ball when trailing 7-6 early in the game.

Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Pioneers 69, Albany Conquest 43

Albany, N.Y., June 18, 2004 - The Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Pioneers ended all suspicion that being the No. 1 ranked team in the af2 Coaches' Poll is a curse by defeating the Albany Conquest by a convincing 69-43 margin on June 18 in front of 7,237 fans at the Pepsi Arena in Albany, N.Y. The Pioneers (9-2), alone in first place in the Northeast Division, became the first number one team in eight weeks to be victorious when holding the top spot in the Coaches' Poll.

Pioneers' QB Tim Hicks, the Baby Ruth Real Deal Offensive Player of the Game, was a stellar 20-of-24 passing for 288 yards with seven TD passes and no interceptions. He led his squad to a 42-7 halftime lead, the largest halftime deficit that the Conquest has faced in franchise history. Hicks threw five TD passes in the first half, including tosses of 16 and 21 yards to WR/DB Leroy McFadden on the teams' first two possessions in the opening quarter. Hicks' primary receiver, though, was offensive specialist J.R. Thomas catching nine passes for 89 yards with two TD catches.

Albany (4-7) mounted a brief comeback in the second half as they went on a 30-14 run, capped by a Timothy Perren one-yard TD run, his second of the game, with 10:45 left

in the game, making the score 55-37. The 18-point deficit was the closest the Conquest got in the second half as Hicks responded with a 35-yard TD strike to Rocco Forgione putting the Pioneers ahead 62-37, before the two teams traded scores in the final minutes.

The Conquest were led by WR/DB Cy Butler, who continued to be a bright spot for the team catching a team-high eight passes for 106 yards, while also rushing for a touchdown. Albany scored five of their six touchdowns on the ground. Albany, N.Y., June 25, 2004 - The Albany Conquest kept their playoff chances alive by recording a 59-26 victory over the Green Bay Blizzard on June 25 in an arenafootball2 game at Pepsi Arena in Albany, N.Y. The Albany Conquest improved to a 5-7 record, while Green Bay fell to 4-8.

WR/LB Jeff Higgins intercepted Green Bay QB Matt Bunyan returning 18 yards for an Albany touchdown putting the Conquest ahead 13-7 with 11:35 remaining in the second quarter. Thomas Herron, playing fullback for the first time this season, scored his first career touchdown, a one-yard run that gave Albany a 20-7 advantage late in the second quarter. Herron carried the ball four times for 13 yards. The Conquest continued to receive strong running from Rashon Burns, carrying five times for 18 yards and his one-yard touchdown run early was Albany's first score of the game.

Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Pioneers 55, Albany Conquest 31

Green Bay Blizzard 49, Albany Conquest 47

Green Bay, Wis., July 9, 2004 - The Green Bay Blizzard overcame a 24-0 first quarter deficit to defeat the Albany Conquest, 49-47, on July 9 at The Resch Center in Green Bay, Wis.

Albany (5-8) limited Green Bay to negative 17 offensive yards in the first quarter and held starting Green Bay QB Richard Pyle to 0-of-3 passing. Trailing 24-0 at the beginning of the second quarter, Green Bay's DeRonn Finley gave the Blizzard the momentum they needed by returning a missed Vinny Cirrincione field goal 55 yards for a touchdown.

Matt Bunyan, who relieved Pyle at quarterback in the second quarter, threw two TD passes before halftime, the latter a 32-yard TD pass to Torrey Day that drew Green Bay to within two points of Albany at the half, 24-22. Bunyan finished the game 13-of-24 passing for 202 yards with four TD passes and one interception.

Green Bay (5-8), took their first lead of the game when Bunyan hit Finley on a 23-yard TD pass giving the Blizzard a 28-24 lead one-minute-and-51 seconds into the second half. Finley had a game-high seven receptions for 92 yards with two TD catches and two missed field goal returns for touchdowns.

Albany took the lead once again at 31-28 on QB D. Bryant's 24-yard touchdown pass to Cy Butler and Cirrincione booted his second field goal of the game, a 32-yard kick giving Albany a 34-28 lead. However, Green Bay responded by taking a 35-34 lead on a Bunyan seven-yard TD run and the Blizzard would never trail again.

Albany, trailing 49-40, received a 23-yard TD pass from Bryant to offensive specialist Tony Locke, narrowing Green Bay's lead to two points, 49-47, with only 18 seconds remaining in the game. Albany converted an onside kick when Rob Green leaped into the air giving Albany possession on its own 11-yard line with 17 seconds left in the game.

Bryant, who finished the game 19-of-37 passing for 271 yards with five TD passes and one interception, hit Locke once again on a 16-yard pass, but Terrance Simms jarred the ball loose from Locke's grip and Chris Martin recovered the fumble as time expired. Locke led all Albany receivers with six catches for 120 yards with three TD catches. Martin gave Green Bay solid field possession all evening returning eight kicks for 217 yards.

Wilkes-Barre, Pa., July 17, 2004 – The Albany Conquest were unable to keep their postseason hopes alive losing 55-31 to division rival Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Pioneers on July 17 at Wachovia Arena in Wilkes-Barre, Pa. With the loss, the Conquest saw their opportunity to reach the sixth and final postseason spot in the American Conference vanish.

Albany Conquest offensive specialist Tony Locke took the game's opening kickoff seven yards deep in Albany's endzone 52 yards to the Wilkes-Barre five-yard line. QB D. Bryant found Cy Butler two plays later on a nine-yard TD pass giving Albany a 7-0 lead early in the game. Bryant found Locke on two scoring passes of a six and 14 yards in the second quarter, the latter to pull Albany to within two points of Wilkes-Barre, 21-19, at halftime. Locke's second TD of the evening tied an Albany Conquest franchise record of 36 all-purpose touchdowns in a season set by Corey Hill in 2002. Bryant was an impressive 14-of-18 passing for 135 yards and three TD in the first half. He finished the game 19-of-31 passing for 213 yards with three TD and one interception.

After leading by just a 21-19 margin at halftime, Wilkes-Barre fullback Kevin Nagle scored on a one-yard touchdown run on Wilkes-Barre's opening drive of the second half to put the Pioneers ahead, 28-19. On Albany's ensuing drive Bryant was picked off by Rocco Forgione who returned the interception to the Albany five-yard line. Pioneers' QB Tim Hicks connected with Forgione on a nine-yard TD strike giving the Pioneers a 34-19 lead with 8:22 remaining in the third quarter. Hicks finished the game 23-of-36 passing for 235 yards and five TD passes. Hicks set a single-season franchise record 70 TD passes with his five TD strikes in the game.

However, Albany battled back when Rashon Burns bounced off would-be tacklers with a three-yard scoring run, his sixth rushing TD of the season, as Albany pulled to within a 34-25 margin with under a minute remaining in the third quarter.

Hicks connected with Leroy McFadden for third time on the evening, this one a 12-yard strike that gave the Pioneers a 41-25 advantage at the beginning of the fourth quarter. McFadden seven catches 79 yards and three touchdown receptions.

Thomas Herron scored his second rushing TD of the season with just under ten minutes left in game as Albany pulled to within ten points, 41-31. Bryant connected with Jeff Higgins on consecutive passes of four and 40 yards during the drive.

Forgione scored on a 14-yard TD run with just under four minutes remaining in the game to put Wilkes-Barre ahead 48-31 and Dave Armstrong had a two-yard run late in the game close out the Pioneers' scoring on the evening.





2004 Game Reviews

Albany Conquest 54, Manchester Wolves 47

Albany, N.Y., July 23, 2004 - WR/DB Cy Butler's nine-yard TD run with 30 seconds left in the game lifted the Albany Conquest to a 54-47 victory over the Manchester Wolves on July 23 at Pepsi Arena in Albany, N.Y. in front of 6,862 fans. The game was the home finale of the 2004 season and was followed by a concert by country music duo, Montgomery Gentry.

In a game that had eight lead changes, including seven in the second half, Manchester (5-10) took a 47-44 lead on a Mel Long 22-yard TD reception from QB Chris Sanders with 5:53 left in the game. Sanders finished 21-of-40 passing for 306 yards with four TD passes and one interception.

Albany (6-9) tied the game at 47-47 on Vinny Cirrincione's second field goal of the game, this one a 26-yard boot with 1:38 left in regulation.

Manchester got the ball on their three-yard line on the ensuing kickoff, but their drive stalled on downs at their own nine-yard line. On first down, Sanders was pressured by Albany's Nick Anderson, which forced an incomplete pass. On consecutive plays on third and fourth down Sanders tried to connect with WR/DB Reggie Robinson down field, but Conquest defensive specialist Travis Coleman recorded back-to-back pass break ups giving Albany the ball back and leading into Butler's game winning run. Butler also caught three passes for 35 yards with one TD reception.

Albany's Tony Locke caught a season-high 10 passes for 170 yards with four TD receptions of 19, 45, 40, and ten yards. Locke set an Albany Conquest single-season franchise record of 40 total touchdowns. Locke had five kickoff returns for 135 yards. He also established Albany's single-season franchise kickoff return yardage record with 1,302 yards.

Albany QB D. Bryant was an impressive 19-of-35 passing for 264 yards with six TD passes and one interception.

Cape Fear Wildcats 44, Albany Conquest 37

Albany, N.Y., July 31, 2004 - The Albany Conquest fell in their 2004 season finale against the Cape Fear Wildcats, 44-37, on July 31 at Crown Coliseum in Fayetteville, N.C.

Cape Fear (12-4) jumped out to an early 14-0 lead on a Jake Eaton six-yard TD pass to George Williams. Eaton, who got the start at QB in place of usual Wildcats' starter Mike Gluski, finished the game 19-of-26 passing for 242 yards with four TD tosses and one interception. Gluski was given the night off to rest for the playoffs since the

Wildcats entered the game locked into a No. 4 seed and first round home game in the ArenaCup Playoffs.

Albany (6-10), who are not going to the playoffs for the first time in the franchise's three-year history, did battle back when QB D. Bryant found offensive specialist Tony Locke on a 15-yard TD pass with 1:31 remaining in the first quarter to make the score 14-6.

Cape Fear, however, rattled off three consecutive scores in the second quarter to take a 34-6 lead with 15 seconds left in the opening half. But, Albany got a last second touchdown just as time expired in the half when Bryant hooked up with Calvin Ceaser on a 37-yard Hail Mary TD pass and the Conquest trailed 34-12 at halftime.

The Conquest outplayed Cape Fear in the third quarter outscoring them 19 to three and drew within a 37-31 score on another Bryant TD pass to Locke with 37 seconds left in the third stanza. Locke finished the game with six catches for 58 yards with three TD receptions. He ended the season with 39 TD receptions, a Conquest single-season franchise record. Bryant concluded the game 19-of-27 passing for 211 yards with five TD passes and one interception.

Cape Fear went ahead 44-31 on an Eaton 15-yard TD pass to offensive specialist Matt Burstein. Burstein, who had been dueling with the Conquest's Locke all season for the league lead in touchdowns, caught eight passes for 109 yards with three TD catches. Burstein finished the season with 45 total touchdowns, while Locke concluded the season with 43.

Albany's final score of the game was a Rashon Burns one-yard TD run, his seventh of the season, as Albany drew within the eventual final score, 44-37, with 42 seconds left in the game, but Albany was unable to convert the ensuing onside kick and Cape Fear got the ball back running out the clock.

2004 In Review

DATES OF SIGNIFICANCE DURING THE 2004 SEASON

APRIL 8, 2004: Albany Conquest announce their 2004 television broadcast schedule and partnerships with NewsChannel 13 WNYT-TV and UPN Capital Region that afforded Capital Regions fans, for the first time ever, the ability to watch all 16 games, home and away, on television, including eight on live TV.

APRIL 10, 2004: The Conquest opened the 2004 season on the road against Cape Fear Wildcats losing 70-55 in Fayetteville, N.C.

APRIL 16, 2004: Albany Conquest played their 2004 home opener in front of 7,129 fans at Pepsi Arena. Despite a 47-34 loss to the Manchester Wolves, fans still had a lot to cheer about in a game that featured the Dallas Cowboys Cheerleaders first appearance to Upstate New York when they performed before kickoff and at halftime.

MAY 8, 2004: Following the resignation of Steve Matthews, who had been the Head Coach of the Conquest for their first four games of the season, Interim Head Coach Dave Bochette guided Albany to their first win of the season, a 52-45 victory over then No. 1 ranked in af2, Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Pioneers at Pepsi Arena. The game also marked the first start of the season for quarterback D. Bryant, who was named Baby Ruth Real Deal Offensive Player of the Game, after going 18-of-28 passing for 210 yards with two TD passes and tied a Conquest franchise record with three rushing touchdowns in the game.

MAY 10, 2004: Albany Conquest name Rick Buffington as new Head Coach, replacing Interim Head Coach Dave Bochette.

MAY 15, 2004: Rick Buffington gets first win as head coach of the Albany Conquest, as he led his squad to a 62-56 victory over the Louisville Fire in Louisville, Ky.

MAY 22, 2004: Albany Conquest offensive specialist Tony Locke tied a single-game franchise record by catching five TD passes in leading the Conquest to their third win in a row, a 56-37 victory over the Macon Knights at Pepsi Arena.

JUNE 6, 2004: Albany Conquest kicker Vinny Cirrincione converted the longest field goal in team history, a 56-yarder, in a 78-51 loss to the Cape Fear Wildcats at Pepsi Arena.

JUNE 15, 2004: Albany Conquest offensive specialist Tony Locke earned arenafootball2's Baby Ruth Real Deal Offensive Player of the Week honors following catching six passes for 174 yards with four receiving touchdowns in leading Albany to a 66-54 victory over the Arkansas Twisters on June 12 in Little Rock, Ark.

JUNE 18, 2004: The Albany Conquest drew a season-high, 7,237 fans to Pepsi Arena, which was also the team's second draw of over 7,000 fans during the season. The Conquest lost the game 69-43 to the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Pioneers, but the Pepsi Arena was still rocking as Blue Oyster Cult played a concert after the game.

JULY 23, 2004: Albany Conquest offensive specialist Tony Locke caught four TD passes to lead the Conquest to a 54-47 victory over the Manchester Wolves in front of 6,862 fans at Pepsi Arena. In the game, which was followed by a concert by country music duo Montgomery Gentry, Locke set the single-season franchise record in total touchdowns (he finished the season by setting the mark at 43 touchdowns).

JULY 31, 2004: In what was Albany's final game of the season, a 44-37 loss to the Cape Fear Wildcats, offensive specialist Tony Locke established the Albany Conquest single-season franchise record with 39 touchdown receptions, his fourth single-season mark set in 2004. He also established single season marks in kickoff return yards (1,362) and combined returns yards (1,369). His 1,362 kickoff return yards was the tenth highest single-season total in af2 history.
