



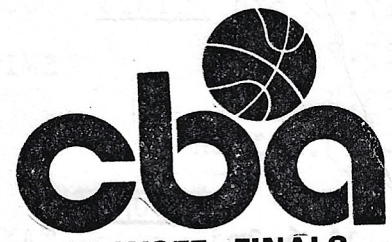

The Zeniths roar into the finals hosting the first three games of the series, before travelling to Montana for the conclusion of the Continental Basketball Association's 35th season.

LEE JOHNSON and AL SMITH lead the Zeniths in playoff scoring, both averaging 29.4 points a game! AL is coming off a 40-point explosion (Z playoff high) in the Z's deciding victory over Philadelphia. LEE JOHNSON is also topping the Zenith rebounding list, pulling down 13.8 a game! JIM BRADLEY is second in that department at 9.4 per, and is shooting 62% (24-39) from the field! GLENN HAGAN is passing off for nearly 13 assists a game, and scoring 25.8 per thru five playoff games! LARRY FOGLE is coming off a 25-point- 13 rebound performance in the final-Philly contest, a 127-103 victory. TIM WATERMAN is averaging 4.4 rebounds in 17.6 minutes per. WAYNE ABRAMS is averaging 5 more points than his regular season average, (13.8 ppg in playoffs) and is making 51% of his shots from the field. MONROE "POPS" MCTAW begins his 15th career CBA playoff game tonight covering three years of post-season play. MAURO PANAGGIO has led the Z's through two playoff rounds, seeking his second CBA championship in as many years! Trainer TOM ELLIS is completing his third year with the club. TOM was one of the original Z's- for the 1978 season in the All-American Basketball Alliance.

The Nuggets advanced for a shot at the CBA crown (in their first year in the league) after sweeping the Alberta Dusters (2 games to none) and disposing of the Billings Volcanos (3 games to one). The defending CBA champs- the Anchorage Knights- were eliminated in a Round One series versus the Volcanos. The Nuggets were in town for a pair of games in January, and dropped both at the War Memorial 130-110 and 117-111.

JOHN DOUGLAS, a 1978 draft of the New Orleans Jazz, was the highest-scoring regular on the team this year at 22.8 ppg- good for 15th place in the CBA Scoring race. Forward PHIL TAYLOR led the Nuggets in rebounding, listing tenth in the league with 9.6 boards a game. Montana lost the super WILLIE SMITH to a slipped disc injury and center GEFF CROMPTON, who was called up to the Portland Trailblazers of the NBA.

The Nuggets played the second-best defense in the league in 1980-81, allowing an average of 113.8 points per game to the opponent. Montana shot only 46.8% from the floor but tied the Zeniths for the best defense against the field goal. Both teams yielded a percentage of 45.1% from the floor!

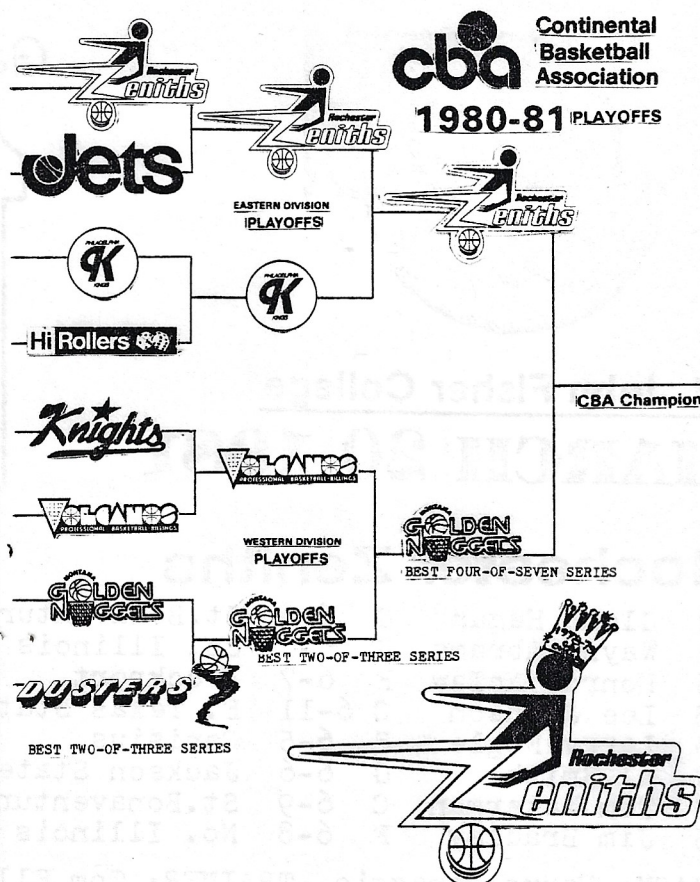
