DETROIT---The Cougars leave Detroit on Saturday for their road game against the New York Generals on Sunday, September 1.

Just last Sunday the Cougars played the Generals at Tiger Stadium and turned on a dazzling display of soccer to run out victors to the tune of 5 goals to nill.

Cougar Coach, Hungarian born Andre Nagy, never a man for predictions regarding results, said, "Although we won comparatively easily last Sunday, we must not overlook the fact that the New York Generals fielded a depleted team and were without some of their star players. My players travel to New York knowing the team they will meet will bear little resemblance to the side we played in Detroit. We have planned this game with the knowledge the Generals are always a difficult team to beat on their own territory and to win we must have all out effort from every member of our team."

This match will be a prelude to an attractive double-header, as immediately following this game, two of the mighties of soccer, Santos of Brazil and Benfica of Portugal, will meet.

It is expected that a capacity crowd will be at Yankee Stadium to see this interesting tussel, partly as they will have the opportunity of watching the two greatest soccer stars in the world, Eusebio for Benfica and Pele for Santos.

It is expected, because of the holiday week-end, many Detroit fans will make the journey to New York for this spectacular event.

The Cougars' next home game is Tuesday, September 3, when they take on the Boston Beacons at 8:00 PM in Tiger Stadium.
