The most exciting major league soccer game of the season for only ONE DOLLAR ... that's what the Toros are offering their fans for this coming Wednesday when they face the powerful Oakland Clippers at Balboa Stadium. (8;00 p.m.)

This game will probably decide the Pacific Division title, but the Toros are staying with the same ticket-price range as for their last home game. This is: one dollar instead of the normal two dollars for general admission, and three dollars for a reserved seat.

The general admission charge is for all fans, but as Wednesday night is usually Ladies' Night at Balboa Stadium, the gals will be admitted at half price to the reserved section only. So, for \$ 1.50 they can have the best seat in the house.

This is great for the family man. Dad pays 3 dollars for his 50- yard seat, mum gets in for \$ 1.50 and their children can sit with them in the reserved section for just one dollar each.

As an extra special treat, the Toros will ask these same prices for their last scheduled home league game of the season next Saturday, September 7th, when they face the Los Angeles wolves. Only exception is that the ladies will have to pay full price in the reserved section.
